# Bible Center Activities

## Bible Center Activities

**Matching Bible Verses with their References:** Print Bible verses you are studying, minus the references, on flashcards (one verse to a card). Print the references to the verses on different cards. Students match each verse with its reference. For example, the verse, "Honor your father and your mother that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you" would be matched with its reference *Exodus 20:12*.

**Assemble the Bible verse on a clothesline:** Print each word of a Bible verse you are studying on a separate card. Cut out a long string of yarn and tape each end to the wall so that it spreads horizontally across it. Clip mini clothespins across the length of the yarn (one for each word of the verse). Students can clip the words to the line in the order of the verse. When playing as a class, you might want to time the kids to see how long it takes them to put the verse in the correct order. Then play again and encourage them to beat their previous time.

**Assemble a Bible verse on a magnetic board:** Print Each word of a Bible verse you are studying on a separate card strip and attach a piece of magnetic tape to the back. Students assemble the verse in the correct order on a magnetic board. Note that you may need to display the verse on the wall for students to refer to.

**Old or New Testament Game:** Reproduce the Old and New Testament Cards from the next page on white cardstock, laminate, and cut apart. Provide two lunch bags or solid color gift bags and tape the Old Testament sign to one and the New Testament sign to the other. Tape the bags to the wall or staple them to a bulletin board in the Bible center. Reproduce the Bible story titles provided and cut out. The story titles are taken from *Bible History for Children and Youth: Text and Study Guide*, a resource by Habakkuk Educational Materials. This book includes stories from both the Old and New Testaments and has black and white illustrations for students to color. The same text with colored illustrations is available in *Old Testament Textbook and Study Guides for Students* and *New Testament Textbook and Study Guides for Students*, also by Habakkuk Educational Materials.

Old Testament stories tell us about events that happened before Jesus came to earth as a baby. In the Old Testament, we learn about Creation, Noah's Ark, the fulfillment of God's promise to give the children of Israel the land of Canaan, and the Babylonian captivity. Significant persons of the Old Testament include Adam and Eve, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, Joshua, Samson, Ruth, Samuel, David, Solomon, Elijah, Elisha, Jeremiah, Daniel, Nehemiah, and Esther.

Stories about Jesus and his disciples are found in the New Testament. In the New Testament, we learn about Jesus' birth, His teachings and miracles, His death and resurrection, and the mission His followers (like Peter, John, and Paul) embarked on to spread the Good News.

Instruct students to read a Bible story title, determine if it is from the Old or New Testament, and categorize it by dropping it in the appropriate bag.
