

Directions: Students categorize each noun card as a person, animal, place, or thing by using a colored paperclip to attach it to ribbon dangling below the corresponding heading. Several cards should also be categorized as common or proper.

A **noun** is a word that names a person (farmer), an animal (horse), a place (farmyard), or thing (corn). Nouns can also name feelings (thankfulness) and ideas. **Proper nouns** are capitalized because they name specific persons, animals, places, or things.


Preparation: Use laminated cutout letters for the "Nouns" title. (In the illustration, light blue, pink, light green, yellow, and light purple letters were used for the title.) Print the heading and noun word cards on white cardstock. Laminate the sheets and cut out the chart pieces. Tape light blue ribbon (or another color of your choice) that is about $1\frac{1}{2}$ -inches wide and a couple of feet long to the back of the *Person, Animal, Place*, and *Thing* heading cards. Use wall-safe tape to tape the heading cards below the title.


Attach two lunch bags, inexpensive colored gift bags without handles, or envelopes towards the bottom of the board and use cutout letters to label one as *Common* and the other as *Proper*.


The first page of cards provided for this activity are spelling words taken from a "Farm Life" theme (lessons 10 and 11) in *Learning Social Studies, Spelling Words, Phonics, and More Simultaneously*, by Habakkuk Educational Materials. The second page of cards includes examples of common and proper nouns. Each week, you can use the blank cards provided to add some of your noun spelling words to the chart. (Picture cards might be used as a variation in place of word cards.)


For proper nouns, you might create cards with:


- the teacher's name, the name of students in your class, or a well-known person (such as a favorite author or the name of the current president) for the *persons* category;
- the name of a classroom pet or a student's pet for the **animal** category;
- the name of your school, the name of your city, and the state you live in for the place category;
- the days of a week, the months of a year, holidays, or the brands of items you use in your classroom for the **things** category.
